BILL TO REPEAL INDIANA'S OBSCENITY LOOPHOLE IS HEADED TO JUDICIARY COMMITTEE IN 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Purple for Parents of Indiana received word early this morning that Senate Bill 12, our bill to repeal Indiana's obscenity loophole which legally allows schools and libraries to distribute pornography to minors, will NOT be headed back to the Senate Education Committee as in previous years. In an interesting move, Senate Pro Tem, Rod Bray, has referred SB12 to the Judiciary Committee chaired by Senator Liz Brown. We find this move both interesting and perplexing. Regardless, we look forward to working with Senator Brown on finally passing this bill in order to protect minors from the dangers of pornography.

Purple for Parents of Indiana has been attempting to remove this loophole for a number of years now with the last two through the Indiana Senate. We believe it is a time for our legislators to finally protect the innocence of minors in the state of Indiana.
